

TEACHING INTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITY

OVERVIEW

Project Zawadi's mission is to ensure Tanzanian children and youth have access to a quality education. Project Zawadi (PZ) is a small non-profit organization that provides support via three programs: Student Sponsorship, School Support (Model Schools), and Teacher Training (Tenda Teachers).

The Model Schools program currently partners with four rural government primary schools to address various needs, including strategic planning, infrastructure (construction) projects, water projects, model farms, leadership development, schools' safety, and student support (via student clubs, life skills, and career counseling). Work is done primarily in the area around Nyamuswa Village in the Bunda District of Mara Region.

INTERNS

We are currently looking for talented local teachers to work as interns in our partner schools. Interns will work as English teachers. They will provide support, coaching and mentoring to other teachers, and support the English clubs.

ENGLISH TEACHER'S RESPONSIBILITIES

- Plan, prepare and deliver lessons according to the English syllabus and aligned with the English teaching methodologies
- Establish and maintain a class decorum that is conducive to learning for all students
- Manage Teaching materials and supplies eg. Books
- Maintain the working relationship with Head Teachers, community leaders and parents
- Support by coaching and mentoring of other English teachers to adopt new methodology of teaching English
- Provide support to English club activities.
- Other duties as may be assigned.



KEY REQUIREMENTS

Include but not limited to bachelor degree or diploma in education/Teaching specialized in English/Linguistic or related studies. Experience working as English Teacher or similar field or background is desired but mot important you will have passion to drive a differences academic life of the children especially in mastering and communicate in English language, Experience living and working in Mara region is a plus

PLACEMENT DURATION

The internship is valid for 12 Month with a possibility of extension up to 24 months, depending on teacher performance, school need and fund availability. Please note that, an intern teacher will not receive any salary but will be given a monthly stiped allowance that cover living expenses.
